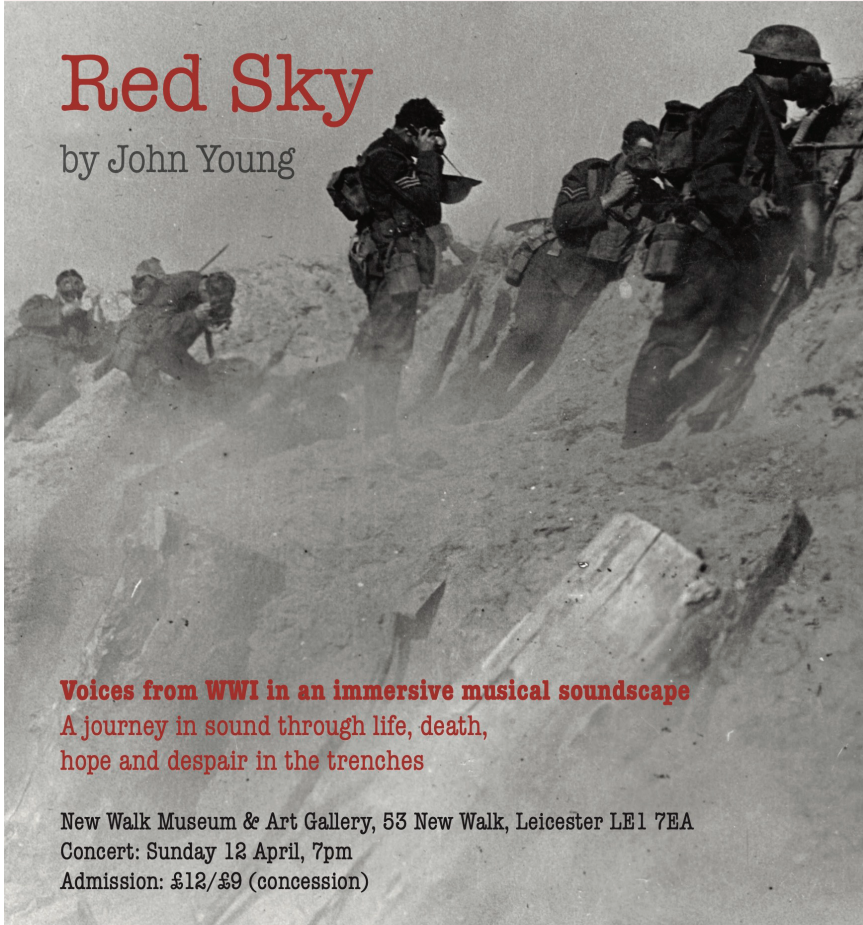

The recorded memories of twenty First World War veterans are reheard in the world premiere of this musical composition evoking images of life, death, hope and despair in the trenches.

Leicester composer John Young has sourced the recordings from the Imperial War Museum's oral history archive and woven them into an immersive musical soundscape, creating a journey through some of the events of the First World War.

The stories, told by men and women who lived through WWI, were all recorded later in life and offer personal and moving insights into key moments of their wartime lives a Compelling 'cinema for the ear' experience.
